Common Interim Order dated: 6-12-2010

1. The interim prayer made by the petitioners in M.P.Nos. 43, 44 & 45 of 2010 is to grant interim stay of the operation of Memo No.CE/Comml/EE/DSM/AEE1/F. Power cut /D.358/10, dated 17-9-2010, pending disposal of the above M.Ps.
2. The above petitions came up for hearing before the Commission on 6-12-2010. The Commission upon perusing the above petitions and connected records and upon hearing both sides passes the following : -

COMMON INTERIM ORDER

“Petitions admitted. Four weeks time granted to TNEB for filing counter and at the end of the four weeks the cases will be listed for arguments. The Commission prima facie does not find adequate grounds to stay the memo of TNEB dated 17-9-2010. The TNEB is permitted to raise demand and energy charges for the excess consumption based on the terms of the impugned memo. Realization of the bill for the excess consumption based on the impugned memo dated 17-9-2010 shall be kept in abeyance till disposal of the petition”.
